Short Trekking Checklist

- 1. Track Permit. Track permit ticket can be purchased at K35/person at the Kokoda Track Authority office located at Brian Bell Plaza, Second Floor, Turumu St. Boroko, NCD.
- 2. Fitness and Health. A trekker/s must be physically and mentally fit before attempting the track.
- 3. **Tour Guide.** A hired local tour operator guide is required to lead short trek and if necessary a porter can be hired also to provide pottering services. A service fee of K70/day for local a guide and K50/day for local porter.
- 4. **Satellite phone.** A satellite phone or an appropriate communication device must be made available during the time of the trek.
- 5. **Pack Weights.** A pack weight should not weigh more than 22.5kg per trekker.

And with issue of Covid 19 pandemic, the Covid 19 new normal rules are applicable.

KTA welcomes and encourages anyone interested to take the opportunity to experience short day trek on Kokoda Track. There are four (4) locations of your choices from the point of return. The table shows the approximate time to each destination at the point of return.
